

Question/Issue/Symptom/Problem:

General Maintenance Recommendations for Ultra Low Temperature Freezers

Resolution/Answer:

Standard Recommendations are below.

Note: Ensure to Reference User Manual for extensive details on recommended maintenance as well.

Continuously Monitor

- Environmental conditions- Room temperature and humidity levels are in acceptable unit tolerance per user manual.
- Door gaskets for frost- If compiled wipe off to avoid door sealing issues.
- Interior walls for frost and ice build up- If more than a 3/8" of ice a defrost should be completed.

Quarterly Clean Air Filter

- The majority of ULT freezers will have at least one air filter located behind bottom front grille panel/door that will need to be cleaned every 3-4 months or whenever dirt or dust is visible. Clean by shaking dust off and rinse under clean water and let dry completely before re-inserting.
- While air filter is removed ensure the condenser coil (looks like radiator) is clean. If clogged or significant dust build up vacuum.

Annually Defrost

- 1. Remove all products and place in another ULT cabinet.
- 2. Turn off the freezer.
- 3. Open the outer door and all inner doors.
- 4. Let the freezer stand with doors open for at least 24 hours. This allows both the interior and foamed refrigerant system to warm to room temperature.
- 5. Dispose of the ice and wipe out any water standing in the bottom of the cabinet.
- 6. If there is freezer odor, wash the interior with a solution of baking soda and warm water.
- 7. Clean the exterior with any common household cleaner.
- 8. Reload from top to bottom with pre frozen product no more than one shelf worth at a time using short door open intervals (Target opening is 30 seconds) and letting unit recover to set point before next door opening.

Annual Position Check

Ensure the following:

- There are 6-8 inches of clearance around the outside (rear & sides) of the freezer for proper air circulation.
- No items stacked on top of freezer
- Unit is level
