Note:

- It is required to install MSQ Plus driver on either a brand-new PC or fresh image of operating system.
- It is a pre-requisite to have MSQ 2.0 SP4 installed before installing MSQ 2.0 SP5.

Follow these instructions to install the MSQ Plus software:

- 1. Download the MSQ Plus 2.0 SP5 driver .zip file.
- 2. Navigate to the downloads and unzip the file.
- 3. To launch the installer, double-click **setup.exe**.
- 4. Follow the prompts and install the software.
